We now can deliver babies as early as 32 weeks gestation, a tremendous asset for our physicians and ultimately those in our community requiring this specialized care.

Safety at our institution continues to be a top priority and area of success. Jupiter Medical Center is the only hospital in Palm Beach County to have earned an "A" safety rating—our fifth in a row—by nationally recognized and respected watchdog organization. The Leapfrog Group.

In FY2020, we also introduced of a number of new technologies including the Varian TrueBeam™ Radiotherapy System for cancer treatment, and GE Healthcare's Signa™ Architect 3T MRI, the fastest diagnostic magnetic resonance imaging available.


Jupiter Medical Center has always been a leader in the region and this year was no exception. In the face of a global pandemic that struck the country and our region with fear and concern for safety, Jupiter Medical Center was one of the first hospitals in the state of Florida to implement the Centers for Disease Control's guidelines for the diagnosis, screening and treatment of COVID-19 patients. The remarkable resilience demonstrated by the entire JMC team and medical staff has demonstrated that in times of uncertainty, this region can be certain about the commitment Jupiter Medical Center has to ensuring and preserving the health of the communities we serve.

Preventing Exposure

Jupiter Medical Center is the only hospital in the region using Care.ai facial scanning systems to conduct thermal temperature screening at facility entry points. Sensors check the body temperature of anyone entering the hospital, including patients, vendors, physicians and all team members. JMC positioned the sensors at each entrance to identify anyone with a fever, accurately and with no contact between patients and staff.

Ensuring Safety in the Hospital

Jupiter Medical Center is the only medical center in Palm Beach County and the Treasure Coast to have fully deployed Tru-D SmartUVC ultraviolet disinfection robots, which use UVC light technology to eliminate viruses and other pathogens on surfaces. The robots disinfect patient and procedural rooms, augmenting the frequent and rigorous cleaning and disinfection protocols being performed by environmental service teams.



Jupiter Medical Center was proud to add nationally renowned cardiologist, Dr. Arthur Katz, as medical director of cardiac surgery. He is highly regarded as the national leader in off-pump coronary artery bypass surgery. Dr. Katz joins a multidisciplinary team that includes some of the most experienced cardiologists and interventional cardiologists in the nation.

The Robson Heart & Vascular Institute at Jupiter Medical Center encompasses a full continuum of cardiac care: wellness and preventive cardiology, noninvasive diagnostic procedures, interventional cardiology, advanced electrophysiology for cardiac arrhythmias, open heart surgery and cardiac rehabilitation, right here in Palm Beach County.

Offering a comprehensive array of cardiac imaging and diagnostic services, as well as minimally invasive and open-heart procedures, Jupiter Medical Center's state-of-the-art facilities are equipped with the most advanced technology and advanced surgical facilities to treat a broad range of heart conditions.

Our dedicated team of cardiologists and cardiac surgeons, assisted by our nurses and cardiac technologists, use the latest techniques and technological advances to deliver high success rates, low complication rates and the best patient outcomes.

Enhanced. State-of-the-Art Facilities

Our state-of-the-art facilities include three cardiac catheterization labs with a dedicated electrophysiology lab, two cardiac surgery operating suites, an eightbed cardiovascular intensive care unit and a dedicated acute recovery unit with specialized staff trained in providing care for preoperative and postoperative cardiac intervention patients.

Level II De George Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU)

Jupiter Medical Center's Level II De George Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) offers state-of-the-art equipment from top of the line incubators and beds, to monitoring equipment, and every little and big supply needed to take care of our special population and the very best team to provide exceptional care to our patients. They have cared for 182 babies since the unit opened in December of 2019. The NICU is equipped to care for babies born as early as 32 weeks with advanced monitoring and technology, a family lounge, treatment rooms, two private nesting rooms to foster bonding and an infant feeding preparation space.

National Safe Sleep Initiative

Best practice and quality initiatives in the NICU include the National Safe Sleep initiative, exclusive human milk and a donor milk program for the sickest most vulnerable infants in our care, and family education initiatives including a pathway to home using bedside charts as a visual and tangible guideline for NICU parents.

In addition to a record setting number of births, 1,716, for 2020, Jupiter Medical Center's compassion and expert maternity care, provided in a cutting-edge facility with all of the comforts of home has been recognized by patients in the region.



Jupiter Medical Center has expanded its imaging, diagnostic and treatment capabilities offer patients the most cutting-edge technologies available today.

GE Discovery[™] MI PET CT

Jupiter Medical Center has expanded its diagnostic imaging capabilities to offer remarkable PET CT technology that combines two distinct diagnostic images. The GE Discovery™ MI PET CT sets a new standard in diagnostic imaging for oncology and provides a clearer picture of the location and extent of cancer. Power and accuracy give the most information about the results of treatment planning, so oncologists know sooner if a particular course of treatment is working—and switch to a more effective treatment if needed.

Varian TrueBeam™ Radiotherapy System

Jupiter Medical Center offers the most advanced radiation therapy with the TrueBeam™ radiotherapy system. Designed to target tumors with precision and power, TrueBeam™ combines sophisticated imaging, radiation delivery and motion management technology to treat even the most challenging cancers in numerous areas of the body, including the lung, liver, kidney, pancreas, abdomen, head and neck, spine, brain, prostate and breast. Stereotactic Body Radiotherapy (SBRT) with TrueBeam™, SBRT allows for the precise delivery of high-dose radiation, immediately after the tumor has been imaged.

Varian TrueBeam™ Radiotherapy System

Intuitive Ion Robotic Bronchoscope

Jupiter Medical Center is the only hospital in the region to adopt the Intuitive Ion endoluminal system, a robotic-assisted platform for minimally invasive biopsy in the lung. Ion helps address a challenging aspect of lung biopsy by enabling physicians to obtain tissue samples from deep within the lung. This minimally invasive technology promises to help diagnose lung cancer earlier, thus improving survival rates.

GE Healthcare SIGNA™ Architect 3T MRI

Jupiter Medical Center installed new scanning technology that combines the advancements in MRI with the sophisticated engineering of a 3.0T wide bore system. The SIGNA™ Architect3T MRI, or 3 Tesla MRI, uses very powerful magnets to produce a 3-tesla magnetic field, which is twice as powerful as the fields used in conventional high-field MRI scanners, and as much as 15 times stronger than low-field or open MRI scanners. This results in a clearer and more complete image. This is another example of Jupiter Medical Center's commitment to providing patients with the latest in diagnostic imaging technology.

Hologic Clarity HD with Genius[™] 3D Mammography

The Margaret W. Niedland Breast Center was one of the first in the state to offer new Clarity HD high-resolution 3D imaging technology on the Genius™ 3D Mammography exam, providing radiologists with the fastest and highest resolution 3D images in the industry to help identify cancers early. This latest innovation is part of our steadfast commitment to superior breast cancer detection and improved breast health for all women.



GENEROSITY AND SUPPORT

The Anderson Family Cancer Institute

In March 2020, Jupiter Medical Center's campus witnessed a dramatic ransformation with the opening of The Anderson Family Cancer Institute on the Crisp Cancer Campus. The Institute is the result of over \$42 million in philanthropic support and brings together highly specialized oncology surgeons, physicians, nurses, and specialists coupled with a multidisciplinary approach and leading-edge technology.

In addition, the Ella Milbank Foshay Cancer Center was extensively renovated and became the Foshay Radiation Oncology Center, housing the next generation of radiosurgery innovations including the CyberKnife M6® radiotherapy system, a non-surgical treatment for inoperable or complex tumors and the TrueBeam radiotherapy system. For certain women, Electron IntraOperative Radiation Therapy provides a single dose of radiation at the time of breast cancer surgery which can dramatically reduce the number of radiation treatments that would normally be needed.

The Next Generation of Diagnostic Imaging

Thanks to a generous gift from Barbara and Joe Charles, Jupiter Medical Center also became the first hospital in the state to produce motion-free images through the General Electric Discovery MI PET CT scanner, which combines positron emission tomography (PET) with computerized technology (CT) to detect small cancerous lesions while producing exceptional imagery and using less radioactive materials.

COVID-19 Relief Fund

In 2020, our community actively fought in the battle against COVID-19 by donating nearly \$2.5 million to Jupiter Medical Center Foundation's COVID-19 Relief Fund. This generous, unplanned philanthropy was used to support frontline workers, acquire PPE and additional equipment such as the Cepheid Molecular System for COVID-19 testing and two TruD Smart6 UVC robots for superior and safe disinfection. What's more, the COVID-19 Relief Fund helped Jupiter Medical Center continue to meet the healthcare needs of our patients and community, despite the long-term financial implications of the coronavirus and support team members who were furloughed during a time when hospitals were required to stop elective procedures.



Advancing Cardiac Care Through Philanthropy

In addition to launching the cardiac surgery program, the Jac Satter Foundation made a generous gift providing the necessary funds to continue building the minimally invasive cardiac surgery program. Surgeons were able to begin performing atrial ablations to treat patients with irregular heart rhythms and in early 2021, electrophysiologists will offer the WATCHMANTM Left Atrial Appendage Closure Device.



Jupiter Outpatient Surgery Center Patient Volume




